Health and Safety Procedures for Sportingnts

In order to support healthy and safe practiceat our OMSDsponsored athletic events the following safeguards will be implemented as a part of our District's practice of layered mitigation.

<u>Parents</u>, if your student is experiencing an OVIDike symptoms please keep them home and inform your school's front office. When you call be sure to share that your child is a member of one of the school sports teams.

Indoor sporting events-

- Maskswill be worn when studenathletes are participating in the sport, as they are able. Masks will be worn by all students while not actively participating in the game.
- · Masksmust be worn by all coaches, staff, parents, and officials.
- · Masksmust be worn by all students taking OMSD buses to and from games
- · Teams wilbracticephysically distancing where possible (seating, sidelines, busing).
- · Spectators will be limitetb 2 per studentathlete.
- Hand washing stations sanitizerwill be available to all participants to promote frequent hand washing.

Outdoor sporting events

- Masks will be optional or spectators and staff. (9/27/21)
- Masks must be worn by athletes not actively participatimthe game(i.e. sitting on the sideline) (9/27/21)
- · Masksmust be worn by all students and staff while riding OMSD buses to and fnormesga
- Spectators may be limiteted 2 per studentathlete.
- · Spectators and teams will physically distammere possible (seating, sidelines, busing).
