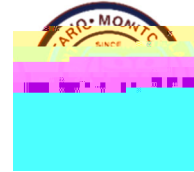

2022 Rose Parade – Dream. Believe. Achieve.

Oaks Middle School's Music Teacher Brittany Martinez performed at the annual 2022 Rose Parade – Dream. Believe. Achieve on January 1, 2022. Ms. Martinez was joined by a nationwide group of 270 band directors and two international band directors from Mexico. As part of their presentation, the Band group showcased their title "Saluting America's Band Directors."

Due to the diverse group of directors, their rehearsal consisted of music teachers across the country doing their own workouts to train. In July 2021, each teacher was responsible for learning and memorizing four songs: Seventy-Six Trombones, Star Spangled Banner, Strike Up the Band, and Sing, Sing Sing. For Brittany Martinez, that was a joy and easy! On December 29, 2021, the group met for their first rehearsal for their first performance at Band Fest. Altogether, they had 10 hours of training. Through the hard work, determination and perseverance of the group, they performed at the 2022 Rose Parade 5.5 miles down Colorado Boulevard in Pasadena, California.

The idea of performing at the Rose Parade started when Karen Sewell's husband, a proclaimed band director from Pickerington, Ohio, passed away in 2017. Four thousand five hundred people came to attend his celebration of life ceremony since Michael Sewell's life had truly impacted their lives. Karen had begun a foundation in his honor but knew she wanted to do more, so she did.

The requirement to be a part of the collaboration included a review of the participant's teaching career, instrument experience, knowledge and processes. After seeing the information, Brittany Martinez, Band Director at Oaks Middle School, the Ontario-Montclair School District, knew she had to apply for it. She was accepted, and that was the beginning of this wonderful journey for Ms. Martinez.

"It is exciting to see our teachers' dedication to pursuing their passion, while being a positive role model who inspires and motivates our OMSD students to keep exploring new opportunities and to continue to learn. Great things are happening in OMSD and we commend the hard work of our fantastic school leaders," stated Oaks Middle School Principal, Nick Zajicek.
